The tournament will be played under the Scratch Stroke Play modality in three consecutive days (18 holes per day) **with cut after the second round.**

PLAYERS

This is an **invitational** tournament for a 44 amateur players, male and female under 26 years old category, of which 20 places for UGP, leaving 24 places available to enter in order of handicap (12 for each category).

REGISTRATION

It must be submitted before 23:59 pm on the 19th of February. The order of entry will be by handicap.

The registration fee will be 165 euro. The registration fee will not be refunded in case of cancellation within 48 hours prior to the tournament. Exceptions will be considered when the cancellation is due to justified reasons of major force. The organization reserves the right to accept or reject such justifications, as well as to determine whether the amount paid will be refunded.

PRACTICE ROUND

The official day for practice round will be on Thursday **26th of February** with a special price of 30 euro. Practice round and the tee times will be booked directly with the Club.

TROLLEYS

The Club has a limited number of Trolleys. They must be booked in advanced directly there.

CADDIES & LASER

Allowed.

BUGGIES

Not allowed.

TEES

White and blue tees.

TEE TIMES

Friday 27th: first round. Tee times from 11:30 hrs.

Saturday 28th: second round. Tee times from 11:30 hrs.

Sunday 1st: final round for players that make the cut. Tee times from 08:30 hrs.

The tee times will be published 24-48 hours before on www.universitygolfspain.com.

WAGR

This tournament will be scored for WAGR as long as it has a minimum of 8 players in the male category and 8 in the female category.

In case the minimum number of players is not reached in any of the categories, the tournament will be mixed and this will be announced in advance, allowing the cancellation of the inscription.

RULES

PLAYERS

Invitational tournament reserved for amateur players with a valid federation license and under 26 years of age.

CATEGORY

Under 26 years old male and female category.

CUT

At the conclusion of the second round, a cut will be applied.

In the male's category, the 65% of the top players in the overall leaderboard, plus all ties for the last qualifying position, will advance to the final round on Sunday.

In the female's category, a minimum of the top 8 players in the overall leaderboard, plus all ties for the last qualifying position, will advance to the final round on Sunday.

GAME MODE

The tournament will be played under the game modality (Stroke play) by individual strokes to 54 holes (18 holes per day) with cut after the second round.

READY GOLF

In stroke play, "Ready Golf" should be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready - you don't have to wait until the farthest away player has played. You will be encouraged by a referee to play "Ready Golf" if your group falls behind.

For example, play Ready Golf:

- When the player farther away has a difficult shot and is assessing options.
- When a longer hitter has to wait for a green to clear.
- On the tee if the player with the honor is delayed.
- By playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball.
- Where possible, advise other player that you are going to play first.

RULES OF THE GAME

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the competition conditions and permanent Local Rules of the RFGA.

REGISTRATION

Registrations must be made at least five days before the start of the test. The order of entry will be by handicap.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS

44 will be the number of players.

TEE TIMES

The start time will be carried out in order of handicap, starting first with the lowest handicap players.

On the second and third day, the starting order will be established by classification.

The Committee vary the order of starts for any other reason if it deems it appropriate.

TEES

White and blue bars.

REPLAY

In case of a tie for first place, it will be resolved by playing hole by hole (from 18th) until one of the players achieves a lower result than the other.

TROPHY

The first and second classified in each category will receive a trophy with the name of the event and Club in which it has been played.

SUSPENSION

If any of the rounds of this tournament cannot be played, the committee will decide how to solve the development of the tournament.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The committee will be formed by a representative of UGP, a representative of the Club and the tournament director.

ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

It is recalled that, in accordance with the regulations contained in Organic Law 3/2013, of 20th June, on the protection of the athlete's health and the fight against doping in sports activity and with current regulations, the Presidency of the Council Superior of Sports, by which the list of substances and methods prohibited in sport is approved, all athletes licensed to participate in official competitions at the state level will have the obligation to submit, in competition and outside of it, to the controls that determined by the Spanish Agency for the Protection of Health in Sports, when so provided.

DATA PROTECTION

In order to comply the established in art. 5 of Organic Law 15/1999, of 13th December, on the Protection of Personal Data, and rules for its development, it is reported that for the proper development of the sports competition is essential to collect personal data from participants and these will be incorporated and processed in a computer file for the registration of players who take part in the Championships, whose purpose is to manage the aforementioned sports competition. UNIVERSITY GOLF PROGRAM SL, with address in Málaga, calle ARPA 1, 29018, is responsible for the file, responsible for the treatment and before which you can exercise the rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition. The participant consents by assigning personal data to UGP to their treatment, which will be restricted to the sporting purpose mentioned that they will not be transferred to third parties except in the cases contemplated in current legislation.
