#### DATE

Friday 22nd, Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th of May 2026.

The tournament will be played under the Scratch Stroke Play modality on three consecutive days (18 holes per day) **with cut after the second round.**

#### PLAYERS

This is an **invitational** tournament reserved for a maximum of 48 amateur players, male and female, born between 1999 and 2011, of which 24 places are for UGP, leaving 24 places available to enter in order of handicap (12 for each category).

#### REGISTRATION

Registrations must be submitted before 23:59 hours on 17th of May. The order of entry will be by handicap.

**The registration fee will be 180 euro.** No cancellations will be accepted and the registration fee will not be refunded once the registration period has ended. Exceptions will be considered when the cancellation is due to justified reasons of force majeure. The organization reserves the right to accept or reject such justifications, as well as to determine whether the amount paid will be refunded.

#### PRACTICE ROUND

## **TROLLEYS**

The Club has a limited number of trolleys. They must be booked in advance directly with the Club.

## **CADDIES & DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES**

Allowed.

## **BUGGIES**

Not allowed.

## **TEES**

Black and blue tees.

## **TEE TIMES**

Tee times will be published on [www.universitygolfspain.com](http://www.universitygolfspain.com) 24-48 hours before the start of the competition.

## **WAGR**

This tournament will be scored for WAGR provided that there is a minimum of 8 players in the male category and 8 players in the female category.

Should the minimum number of players not be reached in any of the categories, the tournament will be played as mixed and this will be announced in advance, allowing cancellation of the registration.

## RULES

### PLAYERS

Invitational tournament reserved for amateur players with a valid federation license.

### CATEGORY

Male and female categories, born between 1999 and 2011.

### CUT

At the conclusion of the second round, a qualifying cut will be applied.

**In the male category**, 60% of the registered players, plus all those tied for the last qualifying position, will advance to the final round on Sunday.

**In the female category**, a minimum of the top 8 players in the overall leaderboard, plus all those tied for the last qualifying position, will advance to the final round on Sunday.

### GAME MODE

The tournament will be played under the individual Stroke Play modality over 54 holes (18 holes per day) with cut after the second round.

### READY GOLF

In Stroke Play, "Ready Golf" must be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready — you do not have to wait until the farthest player has played.

For example, play Ready Golf:

- When the player farthest from the hole has a difficult shot and is assessing options.
- When a longer hitter has to wait for the green to clear.
- On the tee, if the player with the honour is delayed.
- When playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball.
- When advising another player that you are going to play first.

## **RULES OF THE GAME**

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the conditions of competition and the permanent Local Rules of the RFGA.

## **REGISTRATION**

Registrations must be made at least five days before the start of the tournament. **The order of entry will be by handicap.**

## **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PLAYERS**

The maximum number of participants per tournament will be 48 players.

## **STARTING ORDER AND TEE TIMES**

The starting time will be set in order of handicap, with the lowest-handicap players going off first.

On the second day, the starting order will be established by classification.

On the third day, the starting order will be established by reverse classification.

The Committee may vary the order of starts for any other reason if it deems it appropriate.

## **TEES**

Black and blue tees.

## **TIE-BREAK**

In the event of a tie for first place, it will be resolved by playing hole by hole (holes 1 and 18 respectively) until one of the players achieves a lower score than the other.

## **TROPHY**

The first and second classified players in each category will receive a trophy engraved with the name of the event and the Club where it was held.

## **SUSPENSION**

If any of the rounds of this tournament cannot be played, the suspended round or rounds will be considered void for the purposes of classification.

## **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE**

The Committee will be formed by a representative of UGP, a representative of the Club and the tournament director.

## **ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS**

It is recalled that, in accordance with the regulations contained in Organic Law 3/2013, of 20th June, on the protection of the athlete's health and the fight against doping in sports activity, and with the current regulations of the Presidency of the Higher Sports Council, by which the list of substances and methods prohibited in sport is approved, all athletes licensed to participate in official competitions at state level have the obligation to undergo, in and out of competition, the controls determined by the Spanish Agency for the Protection of Health in Sport, when so required.

## **DATA PROTECTION**

In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 of Organic Law 15/1999, of 13th December, on the Protection of Personal Data, and its implementing regulations, it is reported that for the proper development of the sports competition it is essential to collect personal data from the participants, which will be incorporated into and processed in a computer file for the registration of players taking part in the Championships, the sole purpose of which is to manage the aforementioned sports competition. The body responsible for the file, responsible for the processing, and before whom you may exercise the rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition, is UNIVERSITY GOLF PROGRAM SL, with address at calle ARPA 1, 29018, Málaga. By transmitting and assigning personal data to UGP by any means, the participant in the tournament consents to the processing thereof, which will be restricted to the aforementioned sporting purpose, on the understanding that the data will not be transferred to third parties except in the cases provided for in current legislation.
